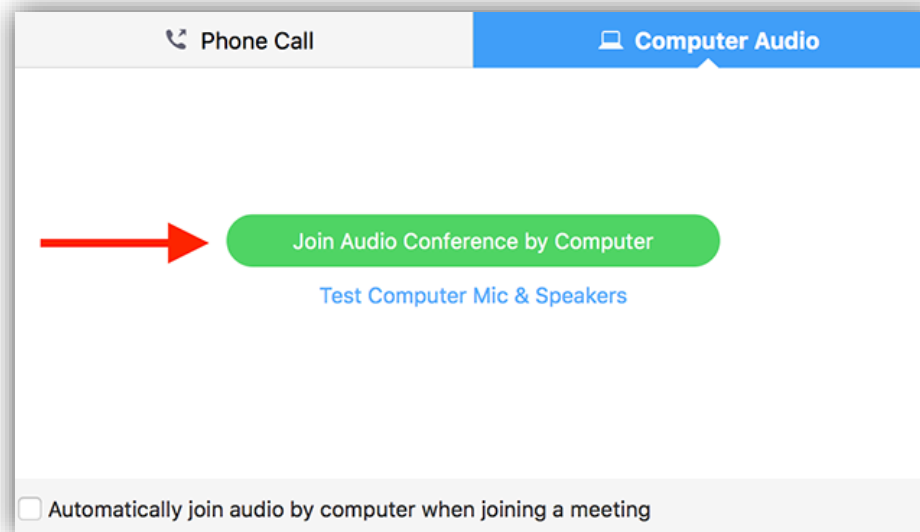


# Meet Our Speaker
